Called To Celebrate Baptism

Our Fall Infant Baptism preparation (for parents of infants and young children) will begin in September. Preparation for Baptisms of infants and young children (thru age 6) is held at Corpus Christi Parish four times a year.

Our three-session Fall Infant Baptism Preparation will be held on Saturdays, September 26, October 3 and 10, **from 1:00-2:30 pm** in the Rectory basement. Infant Baptisms will be celebrated on Sunday, October 11.

Participants join with other families in exploring the Sacrament of Baptism and the commitment it requires of them as parents. Sessions include personal reflection, sharing, and dialogue. Preparation for these sacraments is done in two parts. In part one, as your child enters the age of reason, we help him/her unfold the moral and faith responsibilities we have as Christians. In part two, we help your child explore what it means to be a part of a faith community as a whole.

Youth of the parish who have been baptized, and will be in the 7th through 12th grades in Fall of 2015 are welcome to participate in

the parish Confirmation Preparation Program for Youth.

Youth will participate in preparation sessions at Corpus Christ! and at St. Charles Lwanga Parish (with other Vicariate youth) and in service projects and other special activities

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Registration is also open for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Level I (for children ages 3-5) and Level II (for children ages 8-11). Registration forms and more information is available in the back of church. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation of children, rooted in the Bible, the liturgy of the church, and the educational principles of Maria Montessori. Level I sessions are held on Sundays during the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Level II sessions are scheduled for **Sundays at 9:00 a.m.**

The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is the modern process for becoming a Catholic an opportunity to grow in one's experience of knowing Jesus Christ. We welcome those who have never before been part of a Christian church; those who have been members of

Christian churches that are not Catholic;
Catholics who have been baptized and wish to
continue the process to become a full member
in the Catholic Church. Fall Sessions will begin Sunday, October 11, 2015, at 9:00 am in the rectory dining room.
